Dear Families and Friends,

It has been amazing to see the number of families we have had attending assemblies, the Bonython Briefing and when teaching units have organised parent learning walks. An example of great attendance was at our Mother's Day breakfast earlier this term where we had to cater for 180 people. It was a great event and a wonderful sight to see such great spirit amongst our community. Teaching units have started to invite families in for parent learning walks, where our families can be guided and inquire into what their children have been learning about (content) and learning to do (skills). The parent learning walks are replacing the annual learning journey and are designed to be more frequent at the end of a learning sequence or inquiry. Please keep your eye out for correspondence about the learning walks in the future.

Last week we had another assessment of the traffic that uses Hurtle Avenue and unfortunately our endeavour to seek eligibility for a children's crossing has come back in the negative. The assessment takes place during our peak hours of 8.30-9.10am and 2.50-3.30pm and a warrant system is used to collect data on the number of students that cross the road and the number of cars that use the road. The results came back significantly positive for the number of cars that use the road, however unfortunately not enough students cross the road during these times. The later currently makes us ineligible for a children's crossing. We are looking into other strategies such as speed bumps and updating signage. If you have any personal stories about near misses, safety concerns or other information, please send me an email as it all builds a stronger case. As I have said many times, the ongoing safety of our community is a priority.

The enrolment period for families that are looking at enrolling at Bonython for 2019 closes on June 11 at 9.00am (next week). It is important if you have a preschool aged child and are yet to enrol that you do so as soon as possible as potential places are limited. Please also be aware that if you have a child in preschool this year and intend continuing at Bonython, you do not need to enrol for Kindergarten 2019.

All students at Bonython Primary School benefit each year from the voluntary contributions made from our families. This year we are hoping collectively to reach the target of \$14,000. Voluntary contributions begin at \$110 for one child and there is a slight increase for more than one child at the school. The contributions that each family make have impact on what resources we are able to provide for all students at the school.

Thank you for a great fortnight at Bonython Primary School. If you see me around the school please come and chat about your child's learning.

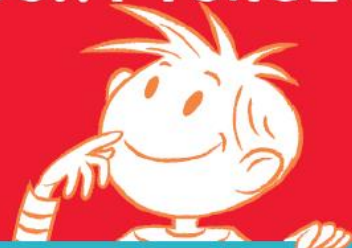
UNIFORM SHOP
