Please note, siblings will be unable to attend this event. - On entering the school site, adults will need to complete the signing in process, using the QR code posted at the gates to the school. - This will be a seated event with seating being appropriately spaced. Only adults from the same household are to sit together. - Photographs must only include adults from the same household. - Any person/s who are unwell need to stay home. - Parents and carers attending the event are encouraged to leave the school as quickly as possible following the conclusion of the event. 	The two adults attending will need to complete and return the RSVP note and will receive tickets to attend the ceremony on the day.
