Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of Health and Physical Education; keeping healthy and practising safe practices around water, the Bonython Primary School Swimming Carnival will be held on Tuesday 19 March 2019 at the Tuggeranong Lakeside Leisure Centre. This carnival will involve all staff and students from Kindy to Year 6. All students will travel by bus to and from the venue, including students competing in the competitive races.

Competitive swimmers, aged 8-12/13years, may enter the 50m and 100m races in freestyle, breaststroke, backstroke and butterfly. See separate entry form for further information if you are interested in competing in these races. Competitive races will commence from 9.30am.

Year 2, 8years (born 2011) students who have competed in the competitive races are invited to join the Tidbinbilla and Namadgi students (Years 3-6) in a variety of 25m races, relays and novelty events in the shallow end of the Main pool. For the 25m races it is paramount that students can swim a recognisable stroke. Year K-2 students and students in Years 3-6 who are non-swimmers or less confident in the water will participate in novelty water activities in the Learner pool and dry land activities within the grounds.

To assist us with planning and preparation of the excursion, ***permission notes and payment need to be returned to the school by 15 March 2019.***

Parents should be aware that staff members are not responsible for injuries or damage to property which may occur on an excursion where, in all circumstances, staff have not been negligent. Parents should warn children of the risk to themselves, to others and to property, of impulsive, wilful or disobedient behaviour.

In the case of unacceptable or dangerous behaviour, arrangements may be made to exclude a child or arrange for them to be sent home at the expense of the parents.

If you fill in this form, your personal information and that of your child will be collected and handled by the ACT Education and Training Directorate (ETD) (Bonython Primary School). This information is necessary for us to manage student participation and attendance at the event, and support the welfare and safety of your child. If you do not consent to supply us with this information your child will be unable to attend/participate in the event.
