Dear Families and Friends,

By now you would have received your child's end of Semester 1 progress report. We encourage families to sit down with their child and 'unpack' the feedback within the report and discuss with them areas of success and how to improve in Semester 2. Please be aware that teachers report on each student against the Achievement Standards from the Australian Curriculum. The Achievement Standards are a guide of where a child should be at, academically at the end of each year of schooling. At this time of the year an end of Semester 1 report will provide parents with their child's progress towards the achievement standard. For example, if a Year 2 child is at the standard in mathematics at the end of this semester it means they are on track to meet the standard by the end of the year. If you have not made a time to meet with your child's teacher to discuss their learning progress, it is not too late. If this week is not convenient please contact us and we will make a time early next term.

To start Term 3, we have a change in staffing. Jacqui Patrick, School Leader C of the Brindabella Unit will be taking on a temporary position at Calwell Primary School. This is a great opportunity for Jacqui to share her experience in another setting and continue to build her capacity as a school leader. I would like to thank Jacqui for her significant contribution to Bonython Primary School over the last six years. Over the next six months she will be missed by staff, students and the community. Although a temporary farewell, we will say some words about Jacqui at the Leadership Assembly on Friday.

You may be aware that we were broken into last week. This continues to be an ongoing problem for a couple of schools in our area. We have had some recent security upgrades and will continue to do so in the upcoming weeks. One that we are interested in exploring is after hours CCTV. This would be set up in a way that maintains the privacy of all children throughout the day and would only be activated after school hours. The cameras are motion sensed and would be set up in a way that they monitor the buildings. At the moment this is being looked at by our Directorate, however would only occur if there is a change of government policy. The School Board and P&C believe this is a positive step forward as our frustrations continue to mount with the significant number of break ins we have had over the past 12 months.

All students at Bonython Primary School benefit each year from the voluntary contributions made from our families. This year we are hoping collectively to reach the target of \$14000. Voluntary contributions begin at \$110 for one child and there is a slight increase for more than one child at the school. The contributions that each family make have impact on what resources we are able to provide for all students at the school.

On behalf of all staff at Bonython Primary School I would like to wish everyone a happy school holiday period. If you are travelling away, please be safe and enjoy your time with your loved ones. If you are staying locally and/or working during this period please keep an eye on our wonderful little school. If there is any suspicious activity please call the police on 131 444 immediately. Thank you for your ongoing support and we will see you all again for Term 3 which starts on Monday 24 July.
